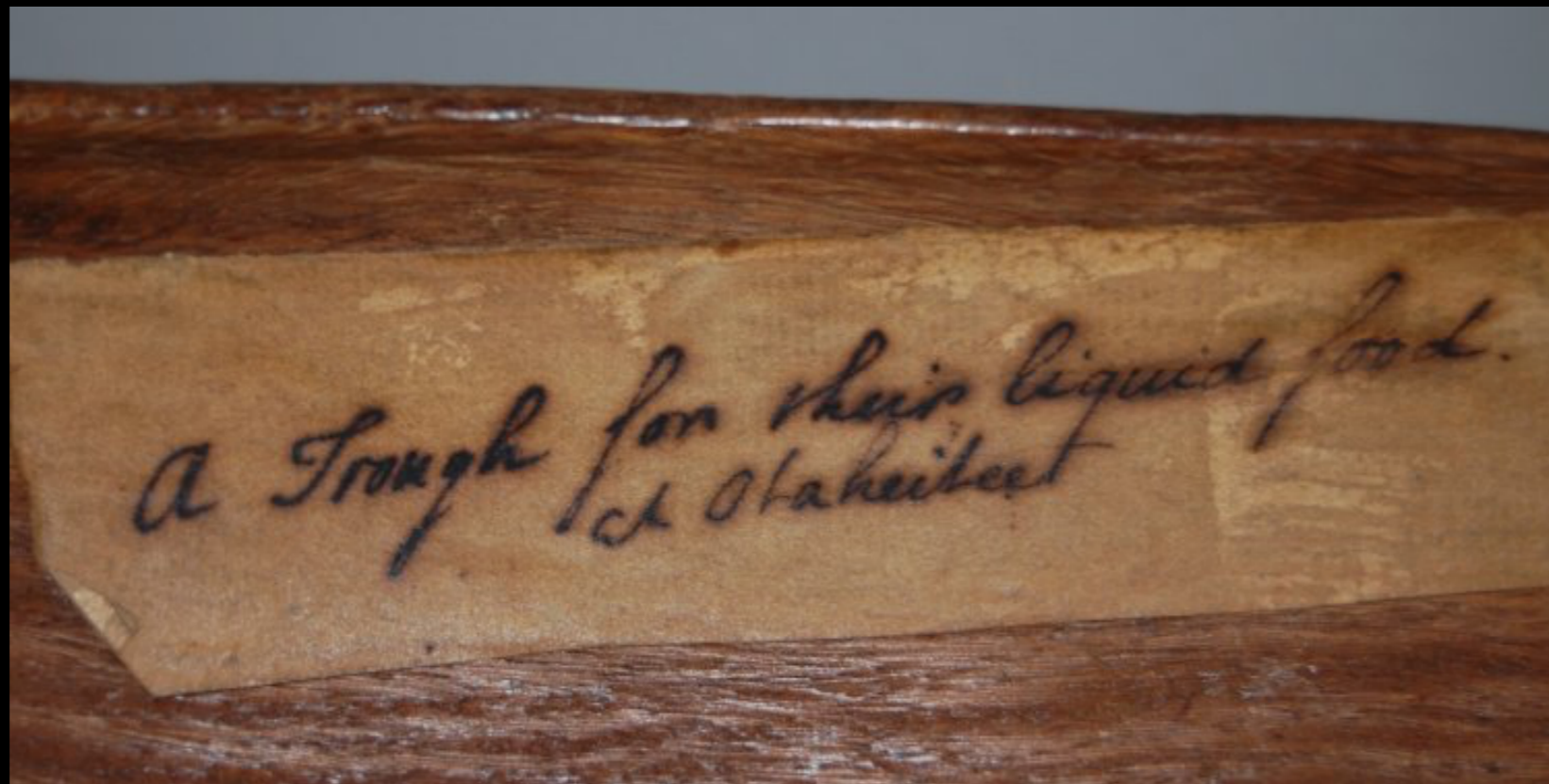

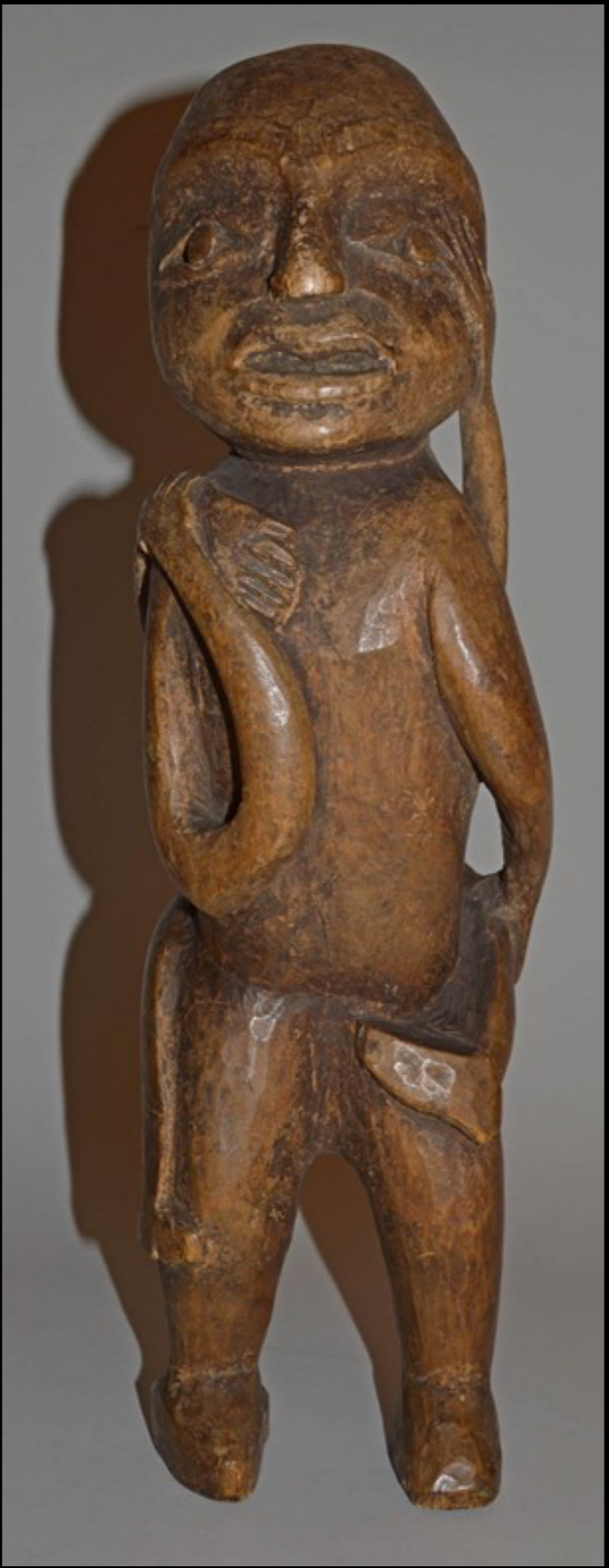

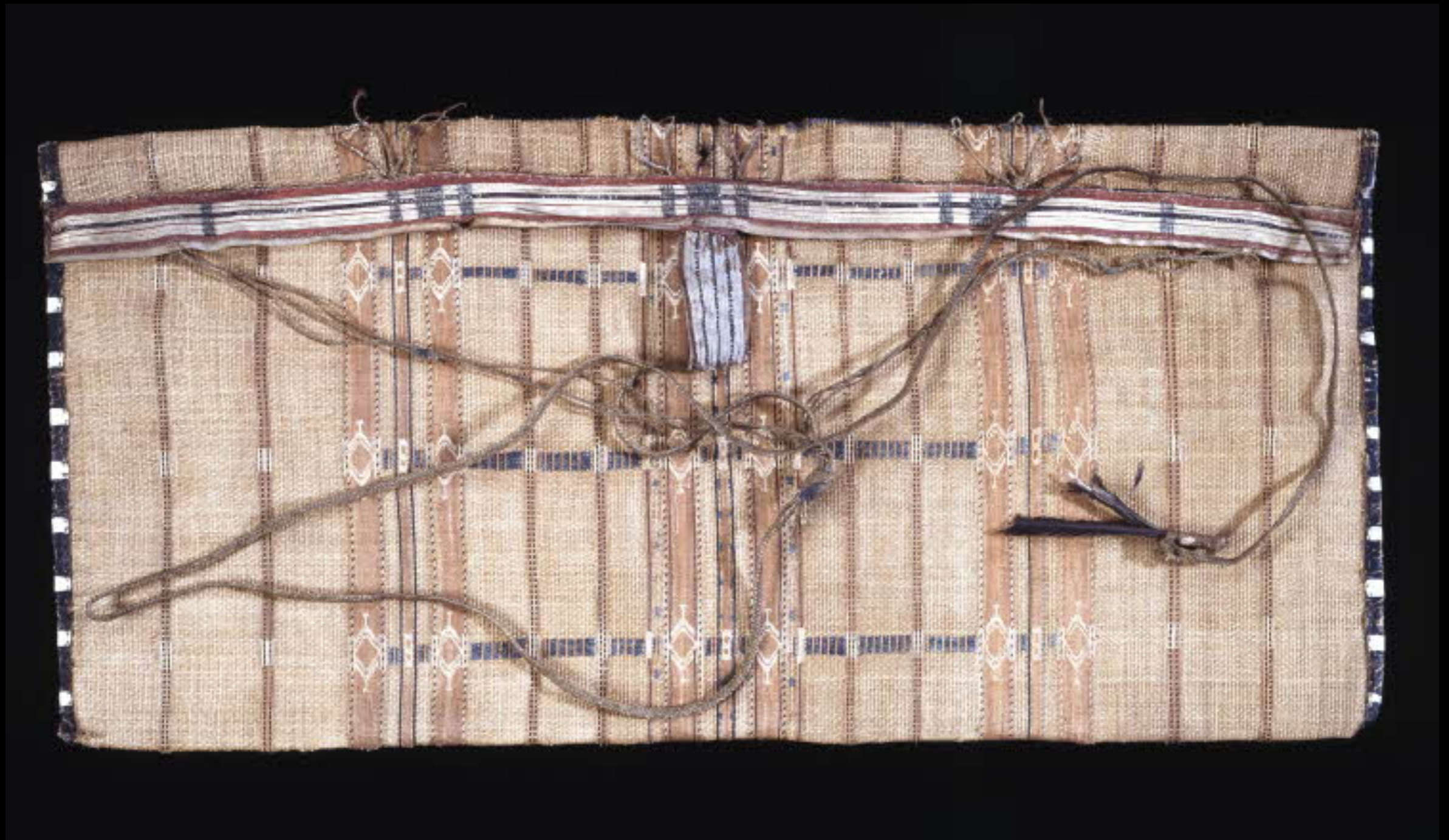
Basalt Stone Hand Maul Made by the Nuu - Chah - Nulth of Northwest Canada

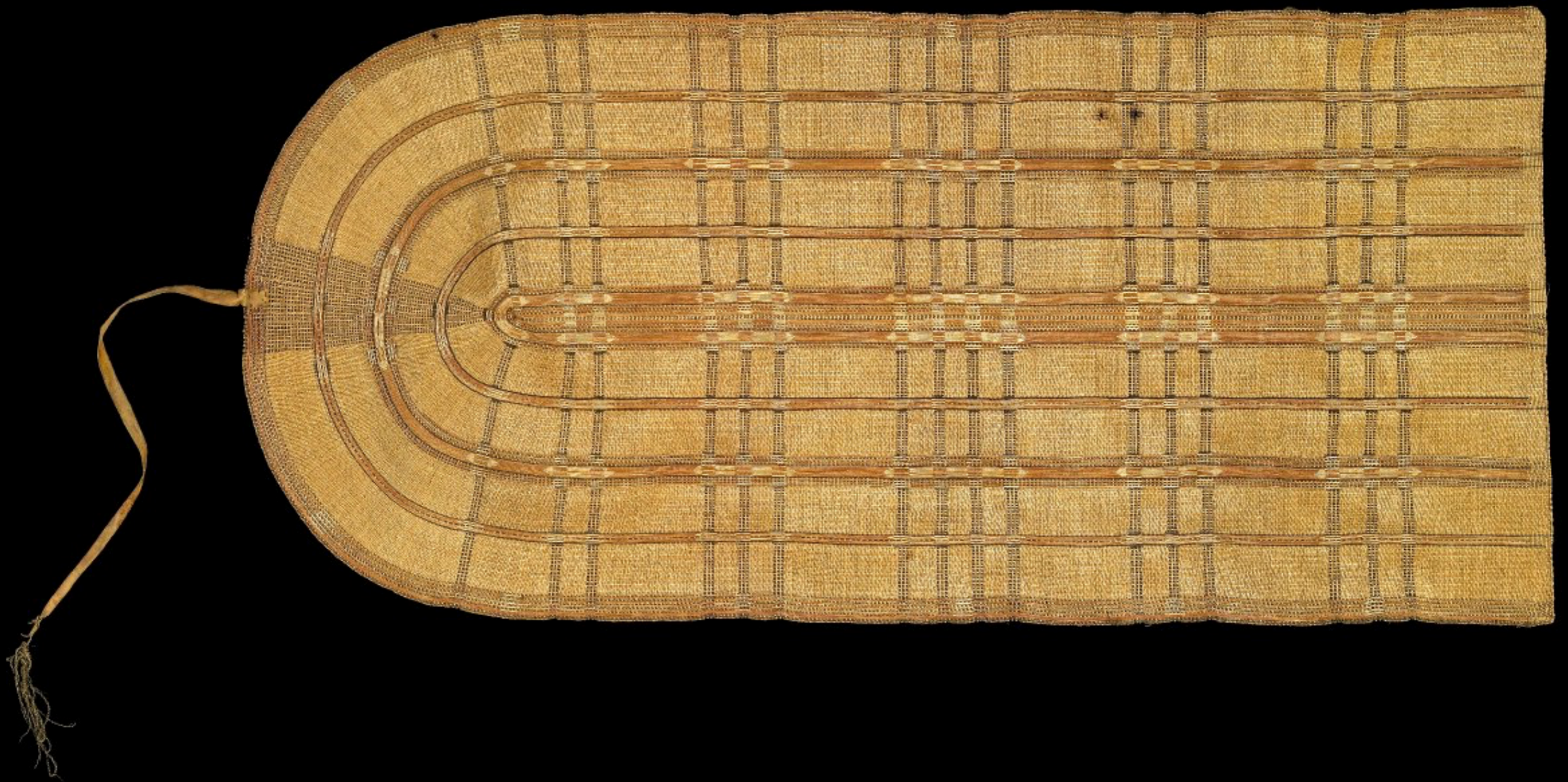

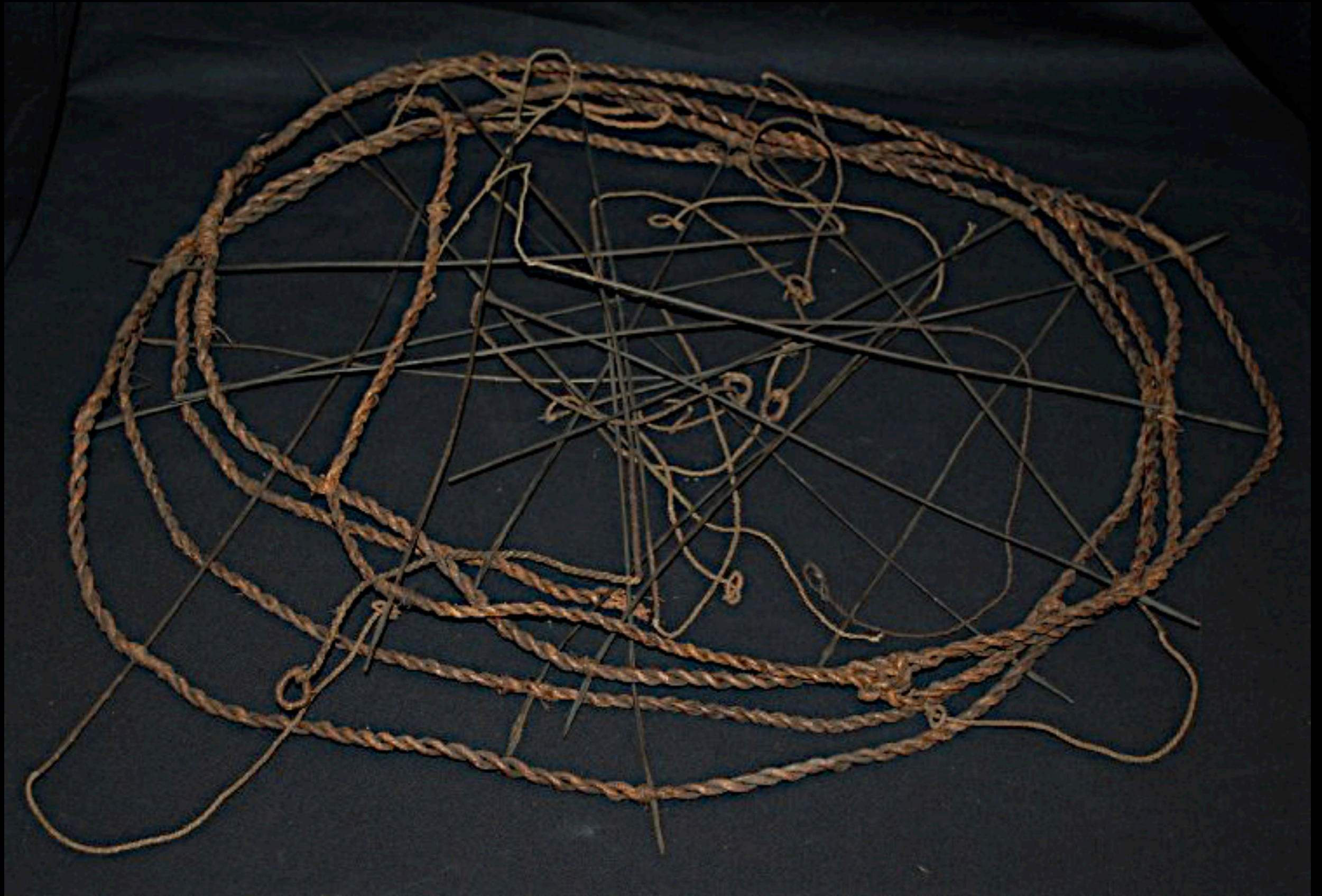

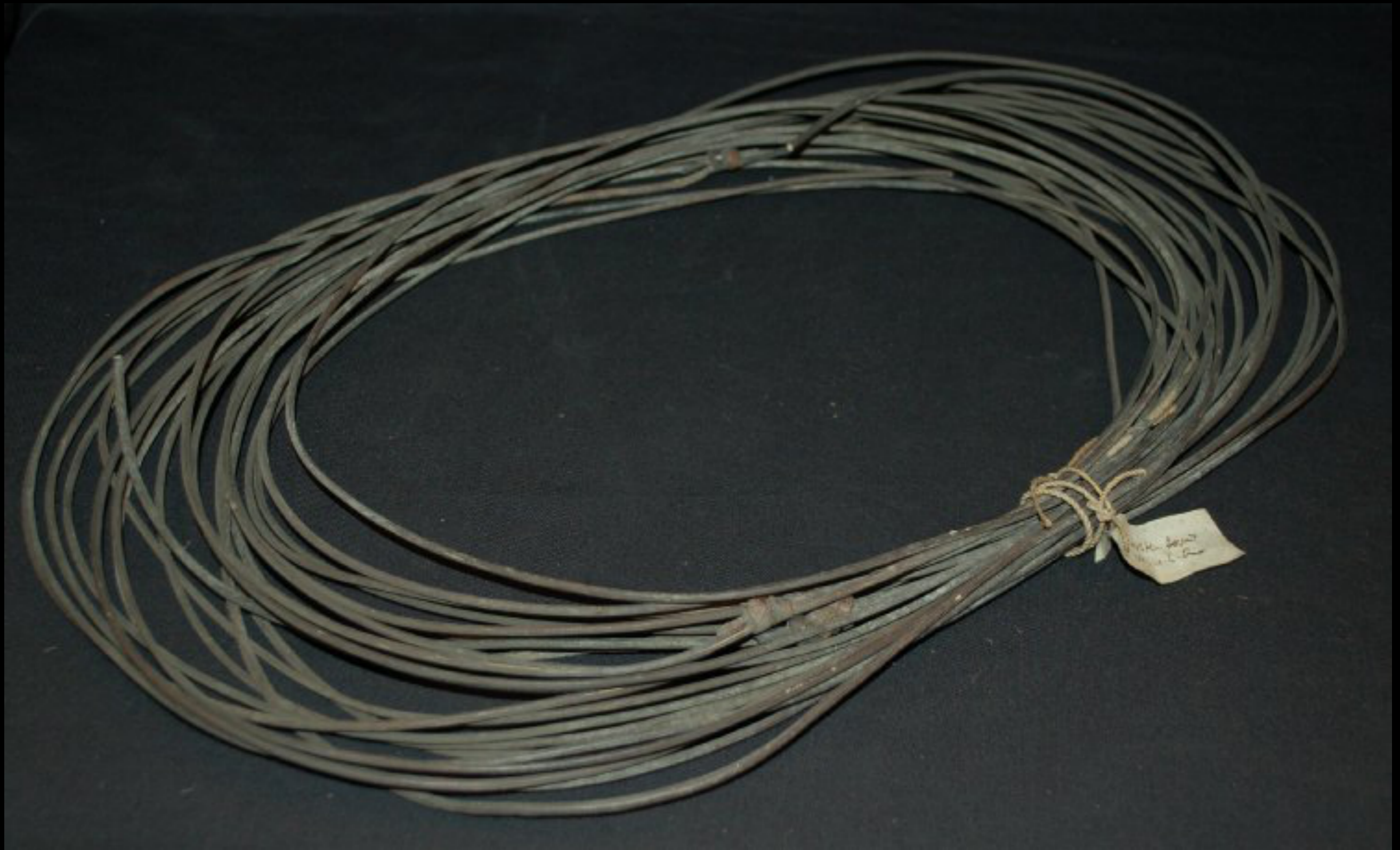
