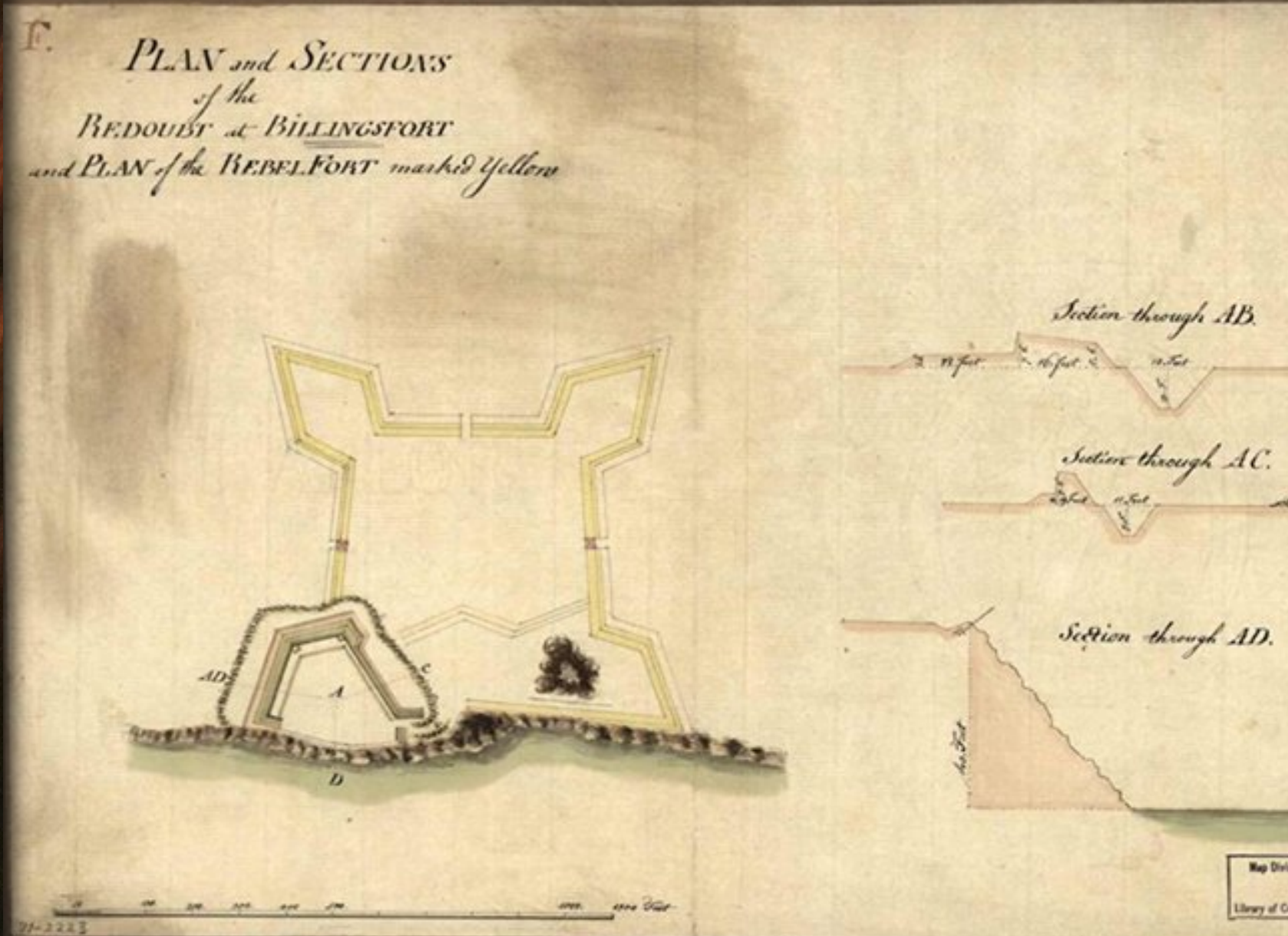

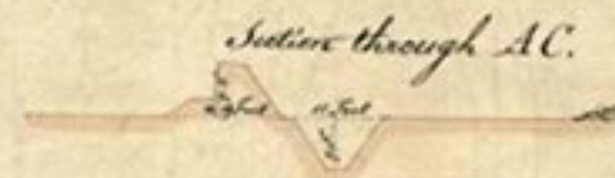
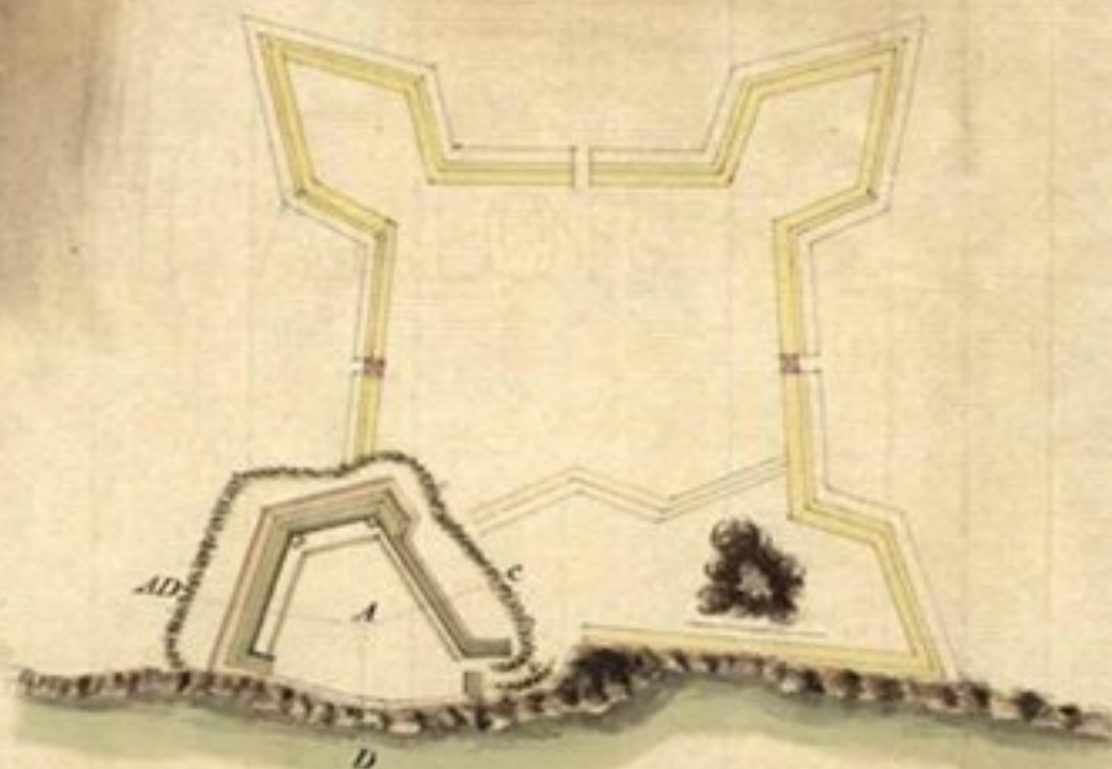

Detail Nassau Hall, Princeton, NJ in 1764

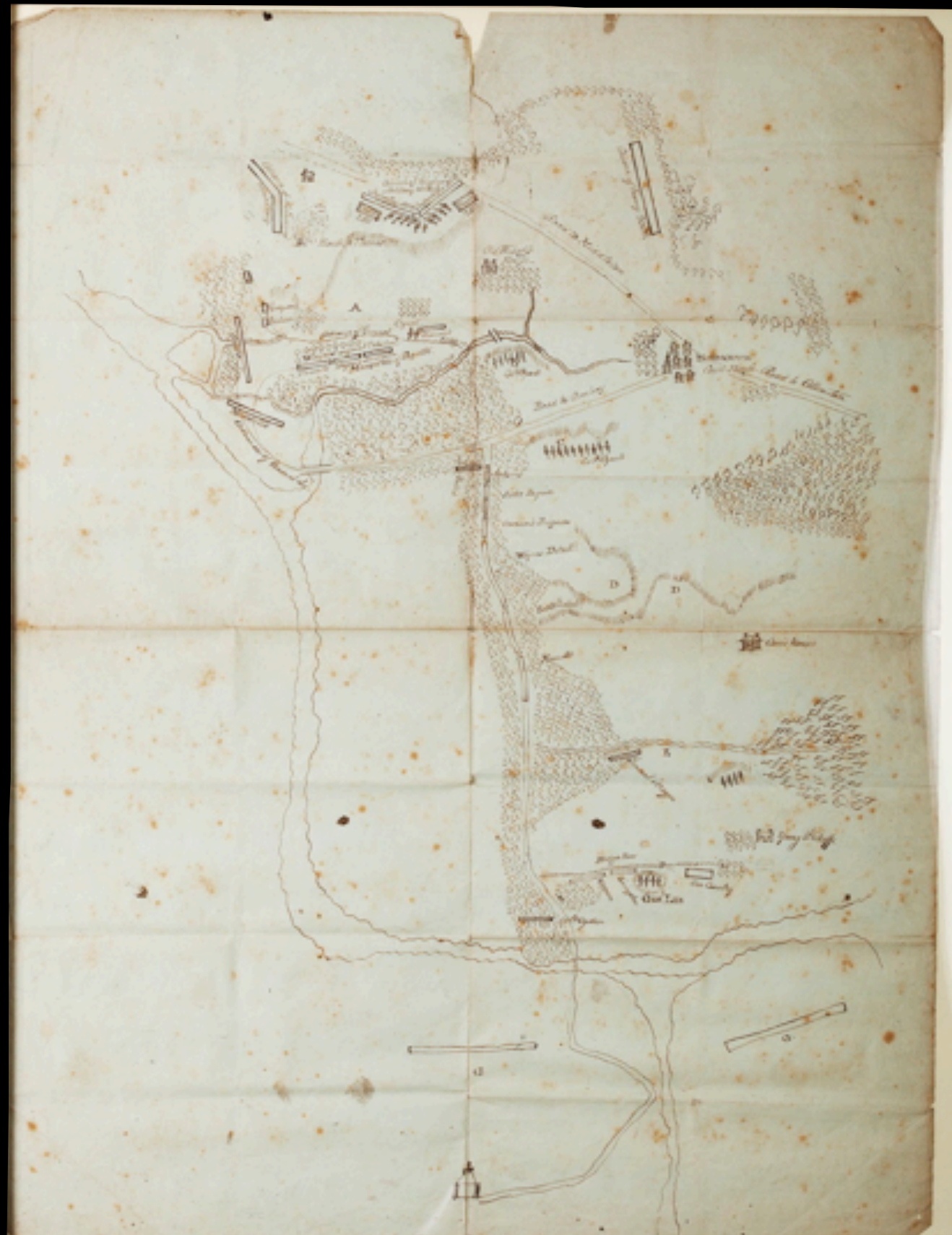
F. *PLAN and SECTIONS

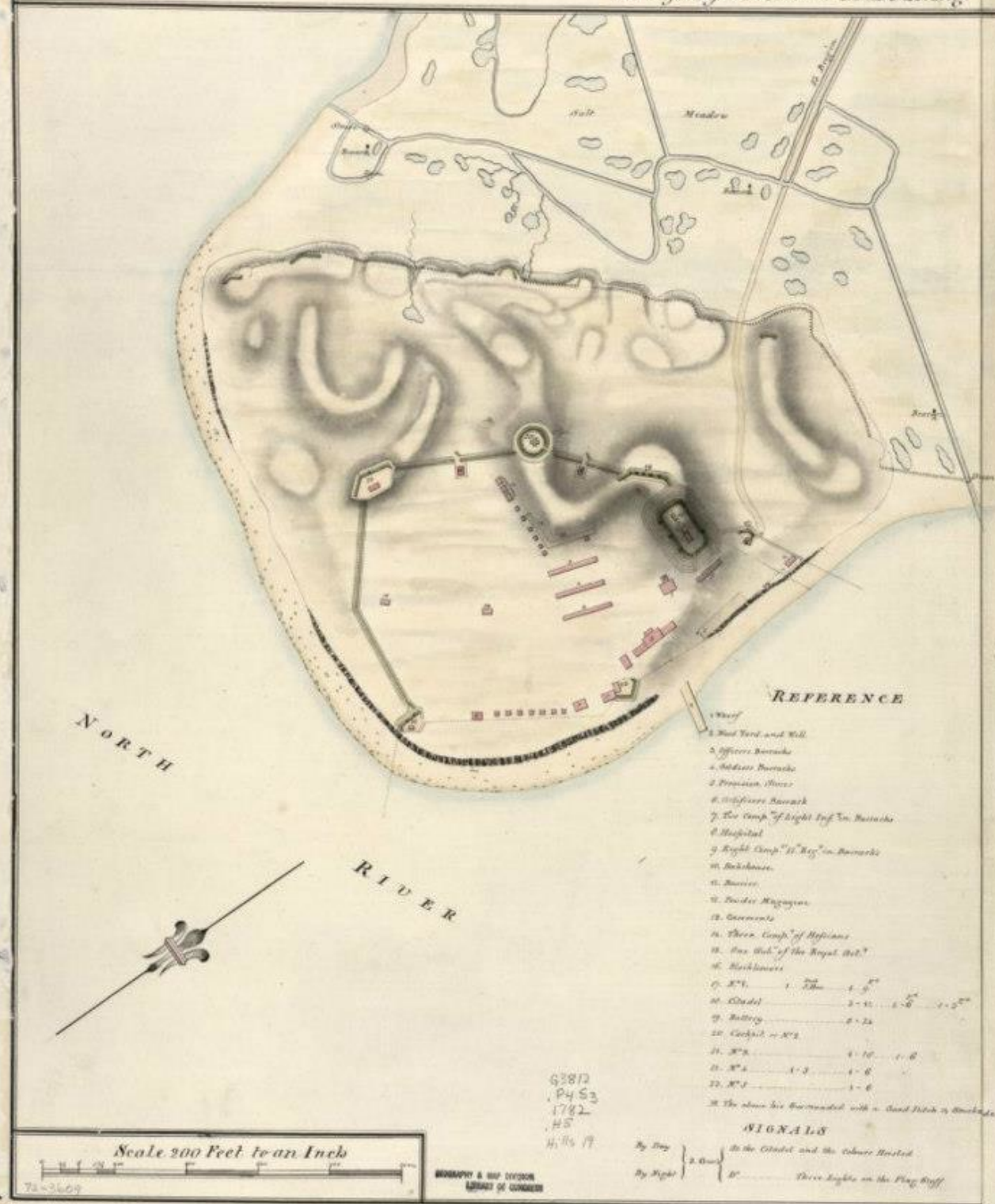
