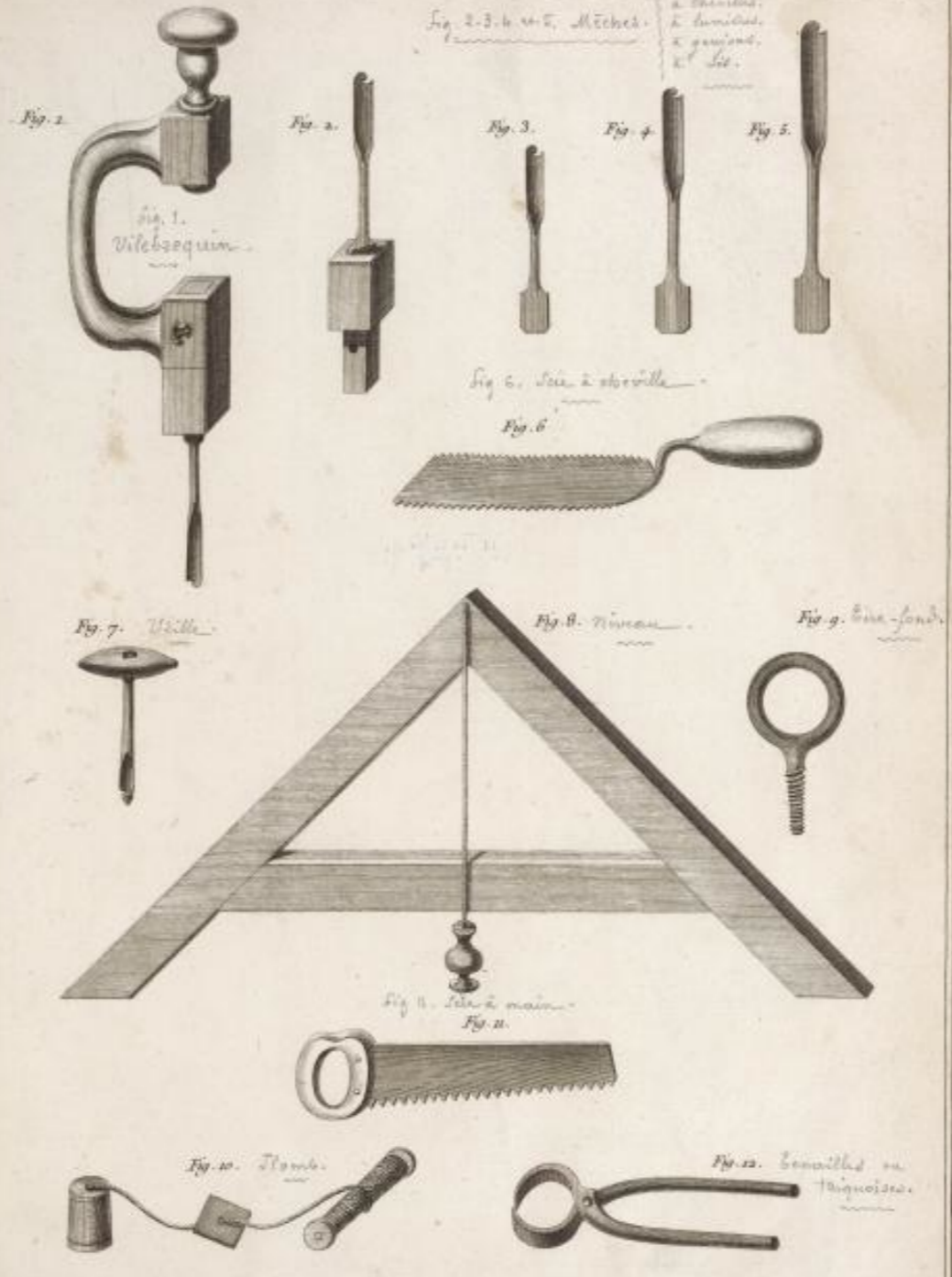

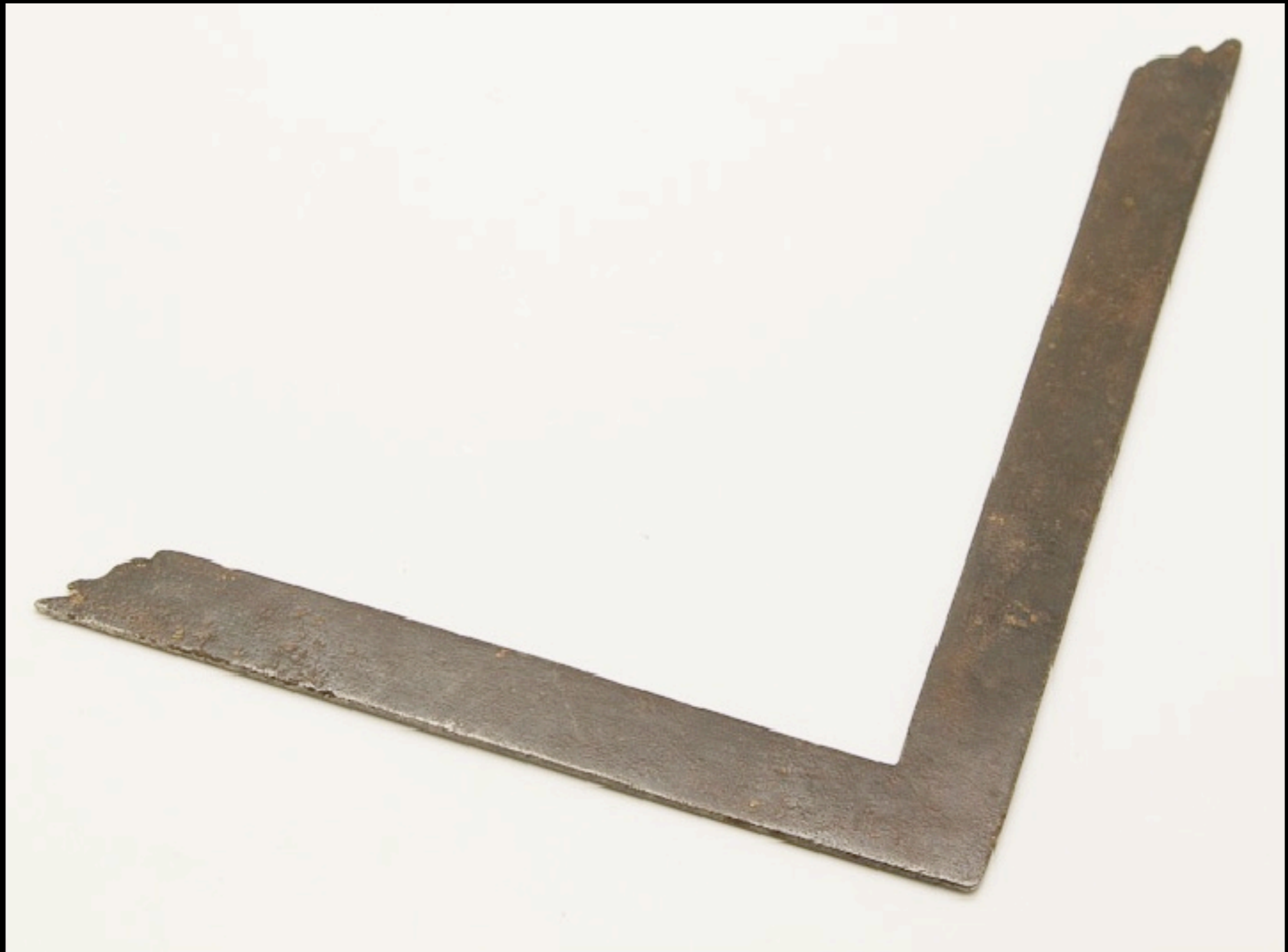

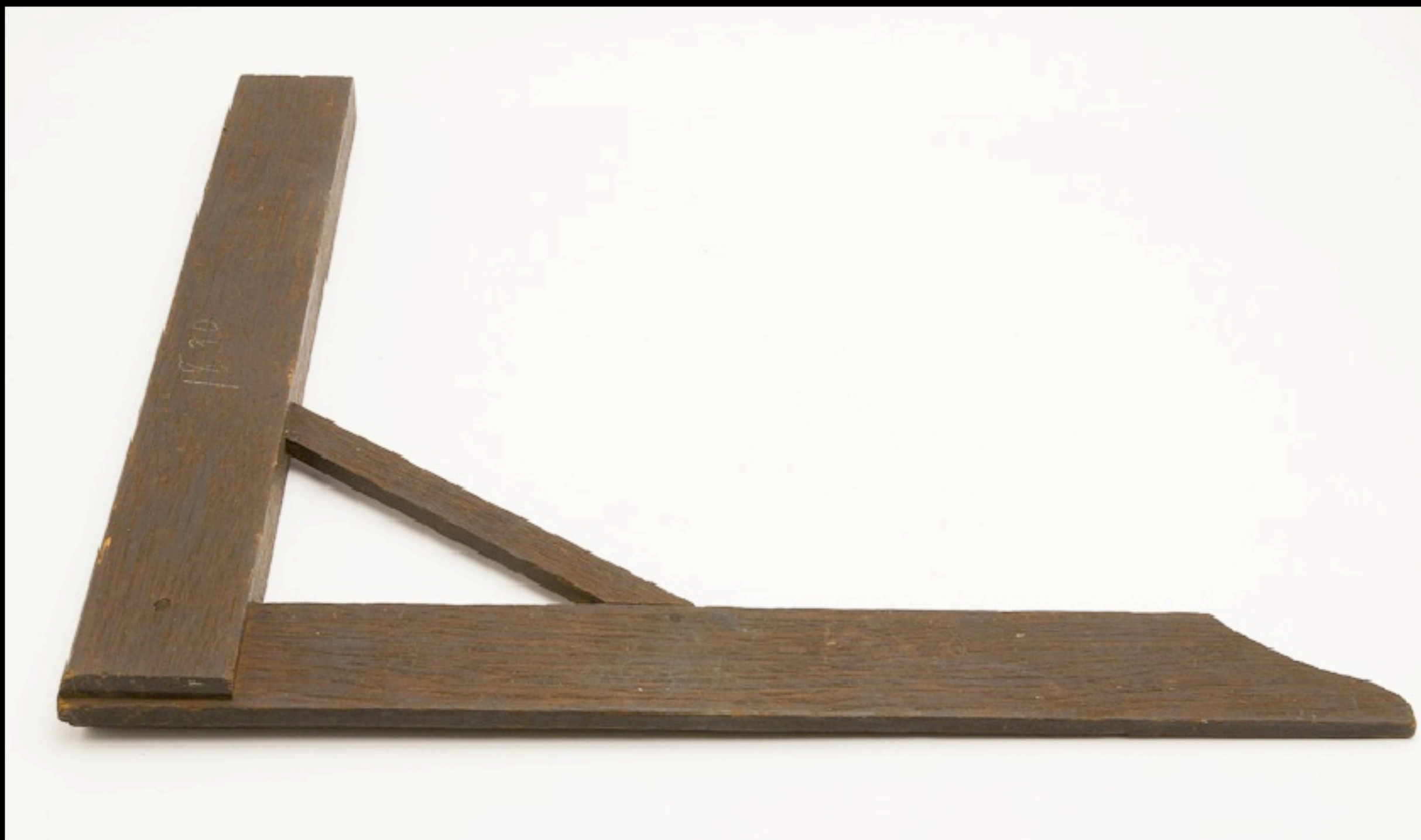
Recreated Carpenter using a Level with Plumb Bob

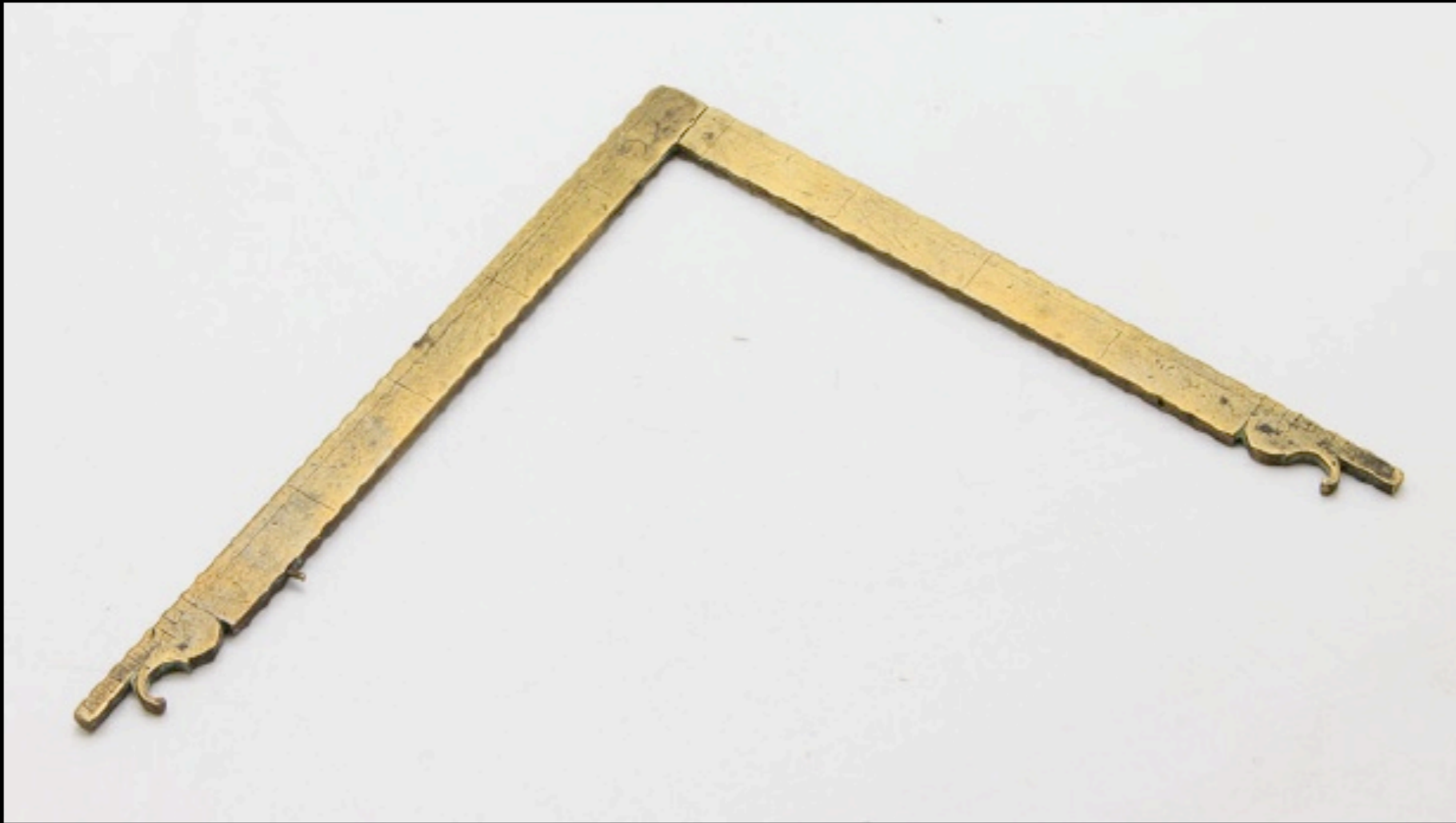

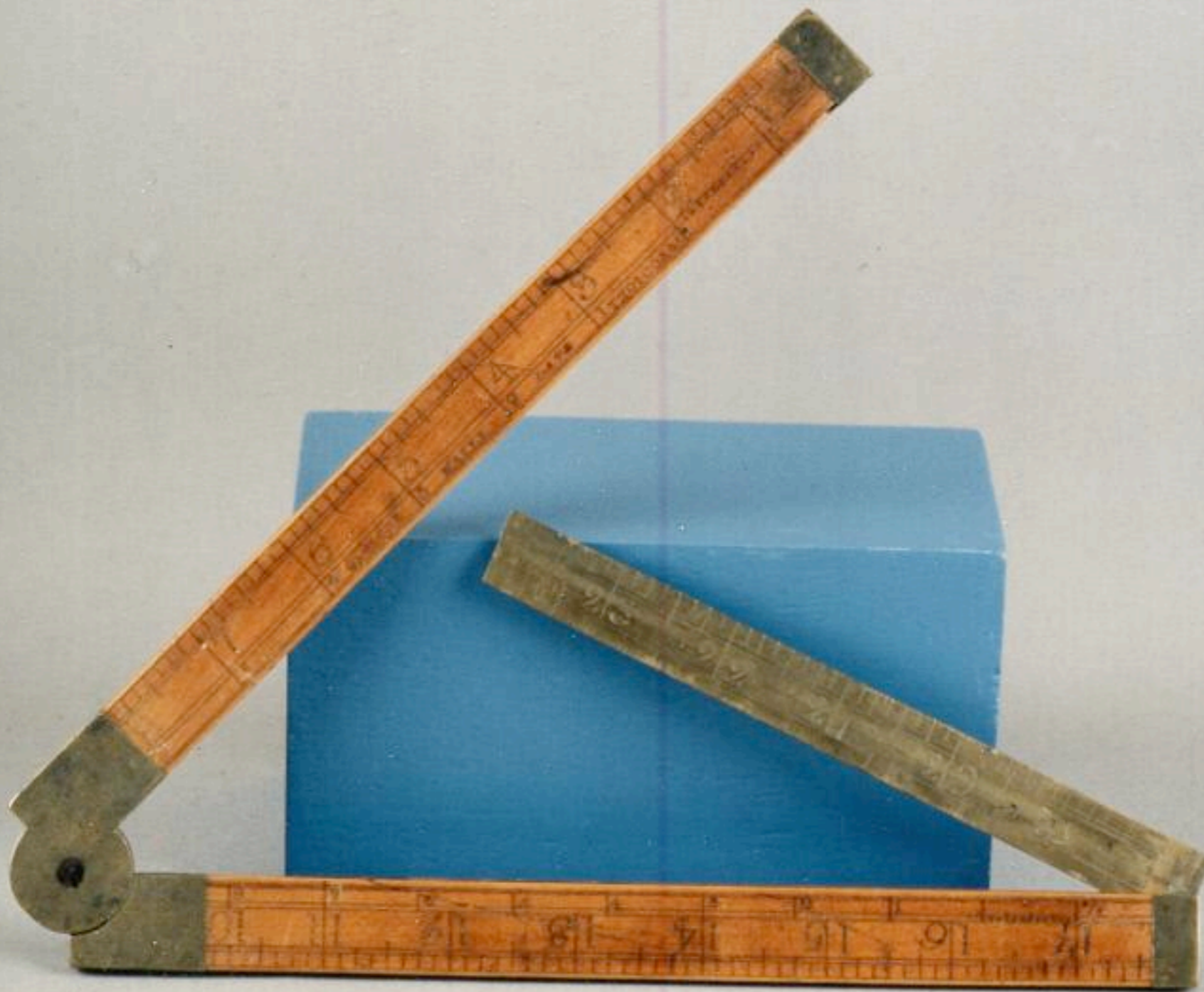

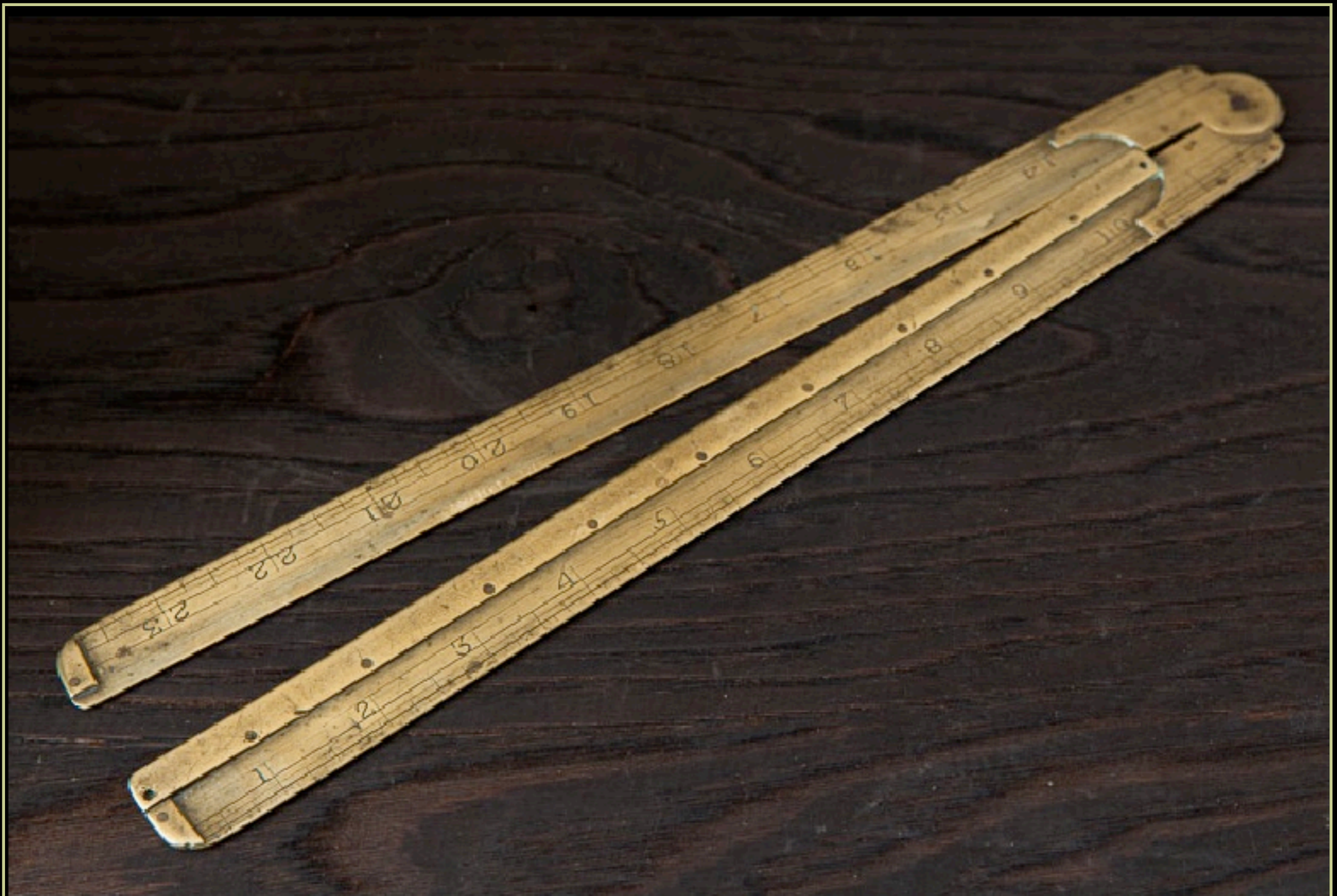
